### AFTERCARE INSTRUCTIONS

Your fitting has a high quality finish and should be treated with care to preserve the visible surfaces.

All surface finishes will wear if not cleaned correctly, the only safe way to clean your mixer is to wipe with a soft damp cloth. Stains can be removed using washing up liquid. All bath cleaning powders and liquids will damage the surface of your fitting, even the non-scratch cleaners. **NOTE: Never use abrasive detergents or disinfectants or those containing alcohol, hydrochloric acid or phosphoric acid.**



# Fitting Instructions & Contents List

#### **INSTALLATION**


The diverter is designed to be fitted onto the G1/2" male outlet of an exposed shower valve to feed water to a rigid riser or handset and hose.

- 1. Identify all components, study diagram and check for completeness, particularly before arranging installation.
- 2. Install the shower valve (not supplied) as directed using the fitting instructions Supplied with that product.
- 3. Connect diverter (1) to shower valve via nut (2) using washer (3).
- 4. The vertical tube from the rigid (not supplied) will connect to the diverter via the compression nut (4) and olive (5) or G1/2" female nut with a flat washer or seal. (depending on the rigid riser's specification).
- 5. Finish fitting rigid riser as per the fitting instructions supplied with flat product.
- 6. Attach hose to diverter using small rubber washer and handset (not supplied).
- 7. Turn on shower and operate diverter in both positions using the diverter lever (a) To switch between the rigid riser and the handset. Check all joints and Connections for leaks.

### **MAINTENANCE**

### If either fitting begins to drip during operation:

- 1. Ensure shower control is in the 'off' position.
- 2. Unscrew lever (a) loosen grub screw (b), diverter head (c) and unscrew valve.
- 3. Carefully clean seating, rubber washer.
- 4. Replace valve and handle then test shower.
- 5. Contact our helpline if problem persists.
